Touch Football Australia (TFA) and Touch New Zealand (TNZ) have recently announced the 2010 Masters Trans Tasman Test Series. The series (MTTTS) will be held in Townsville in conjunction with the North Queensland Senior Championships at Queens Park, on Saturday, 12th and Sunday, 13th June 2010. Participants will be expected to arrive in Townsville prior to 12 noon on Wednesday 9th June and will depart the tour on Monday 14th.

TFA is now seeking Managers to assist the Australian Masters Trans Tasman Teams for the 2010 MTTTS.

The appointments will be made for this 2010 series only, however strong performances at the 2010 MTTTS will be taken into consideration when appointments are made for the 2011 World Cup.

The compulsory camp will commence on with a Friday afternoon arrival and will conclude on the Sunday after lunch (exact dates to be advised).

The appointed managers will also be asked to pay a tour levy which will be the same amount as the players. However there may be a rebate forthcoming after the event for managers who complete all of the assigned tasks of reporting. Over the next few days TFA will be releasing details of the tour and associated levy amounts.
